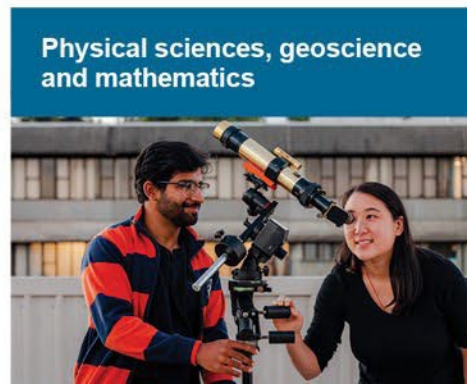

Master of Advanced Practice

Wound, Ostomy & Continence Practice Major

- This specialisation responds to the increasing need for specialist nursing practice in the prevention and management of patients with acute or chronic wounds, ostomies and incontinence.
- The Master of Advanced Practice aims to develop graduates who possess a combination of knowledge and research skills applicable to industry
- Enrolment can be full time or part time. Study plan can be negotiated. A part time study plan is essential for specialisations that are linked to employments



MC-ADVPRC Master of Advanced Practice Course Structure

First Semester (50 Credits)
MEDS6013 (25 Credits) Research and Evaluation in Health
NURS5005 (25 Credits) Evidence Informed Clinical Practice
Second Semester (50 Credits)
HEAL6002 (50 Credits) Health Research Professional Project

Research and Evaluation in Health (MEDS6013)

- This unit introduces students to the basic principles of qualitative, quantitative, and mixed methods research approaches.
- Ethical considerations of conducting research, consumer engagement and evaluation of health interventions are also explored.
- **Assessments**
 - ✓ Written review – identifying ethical issues in unethical study
 - ✓ Written analysis – Critiquing a research paper guided by a model
 - ✓ Written examination – Multiple choice, short answer and long answer questions



Evidence Informed Clinical Practice (NURS5005)

- This unit takes students through the steps of addressing a clinical research problem.
- Students explore structured approaches to translate and implement evidence into practice, measure its impact and understand how to ensure sustainability.

Assessments

- ✓ Written paper 1
- ✓ Written paper 2



Health Research Professional Project (HEAL6002)

- This unit is the final part of the Master of Advanced Practice course, which requires students to identify and complete a small research project.
- Students will undertake an independent project over a period of one semester.
- **Assessments**
 - ✓ Project concept
 - ✓ Project progress report
 - ✓ Project report



Entry Requirements

Course	Entry
Master of Advanced Practice <i>WOC entry</i>	A bachelor degree in a related health field with course weighted average of 70% and 3 years work experience. Evidence of Canadian nursing registration and proof of NSWOC certification.

English Requirement

Proof of English competency must also be submitted:

Successful completion of an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree awarded by a recognised University in Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, Singapore, South Africa, United Kingdom or United States of America; or


Achieve the required result from an approved English language proficiency tests, the test must have been undertaken within two years of application, however, they may be used for entry until the next immediate semester intake.

Applying to Curtin

1. Find your course - <https://www.curtin.edu.au/study/offering/course-pg-master-of-advanced-practice--mc-advprc/>
2. Click 'Apply Now' on the page
3. A pop up will appear on the screen, you can apply directly to the university.
4. You will then be taken to a sign-in page. Select 'New User-register here' and create a user account.
5. Sign in to the account and select 'Add new application' (under My Applications)
6. In the search field search for MC-ADVPRC or the course name and the preferred commencement year (2025 or 2026)
7. Add the course and select 'Next'
8. Enter your applicant details, if you are not using an agent this can be left blank. Under citizenship select 'Overseas Student Residing Overseas'
9. You will then be prompted to upload proof of English proficiency, Resume, Proof of Registration etc for assessment. Please ensure you indicate under 'Credit for Recognised Learning' your NSWOC experience.

Accepting your offer

1. Once approved you will receive an offer to study at Curtin University.
